Definitions

Sexual Abuse

Sexual abuse is any forced or unwanted sexual behavior. It can be physical (contact), verbal (comments, rumors, e-mail, notes, pornography, graffiti, etc.) or non-verbal/non-physical (gestures, peeping in windows/bathrooms, etc).

Sexual Assault

Sexual assault is any forced or unwanted touch to the sexual parts of a person's body.

Rape

Rape is any forced or unwanted penetration of the any part of the victims' body by any part of the offender's body, or by an object. This includes forced oral, vaginal, and anal penetration.

Sexual Harassment

Sexual harassment is unwanted, sexual attention. Sexual harassment includes obscene phone calls, jokes, gestures, and teasing. Sexual harassment is determined by how the victim feels about the behavior, not by what the offender intended. Sexual harassment is different from flirting. Flirting is wanted, mutual, and complimentary. Sexual harassment is unwanted, one-sided and degrading. It is illegal when it occurs in school or in the workplace.
