SUBMISSION CHECKLIST

(HELPFUL!)

- Our ad is not victim-blaming. It does not contain any statements that make it seem like a victim did something wrong, or should have done something differently than what she/he did.
- Our ad reinforces that most men do not tolerate sexual violence and that boys and men can be part of the solution to end sexual violence.
- Our ad promotes healthy behaviors or dispels a myth, misconception, comment or attitude, and shows that bystanders have the ability to help prevent sexual harassment from happening in the first place.
- Our ad targets teens.
- Our ad is under :30 seconds.
- If submitting a video, it is in Windows Media Player (.wmv) or Quicktime (.mov) format on a CD-R or DVD- R (NOT a CD-RW or DVD-RW). Please make sure that your CD/DVD has been finalized so we can open your file! If we cannot open it, we cannot judge it!
- We have included the required Day One tagline in our ad: We need your help to stop sexual violence. Be part of the solution. To get involved visit dayoneri.org or call Day One at (401) 421-4100.
- We have included the TYPED script and TYPED team members' names with our entry.
- Our team consists of at least one male and 3-4 members total.
