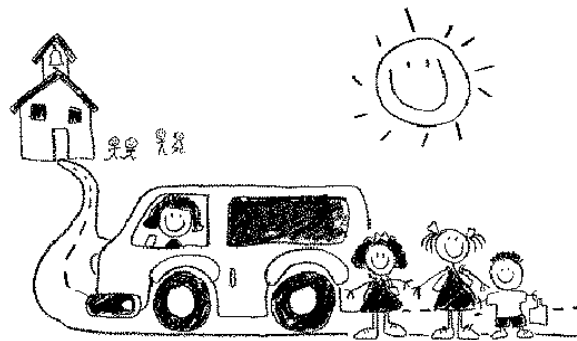


# Keeping Kids Safe

## WORKSHOPS FOR PARENTS AND CARETAKERS ON CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE

The Sexual Assault & Trauma Resource Center of RI offers a series of training sessions for parents, teachers, and other adults who work with children and teenagers. Workshops are designed to educate adults about abuse awareness and prevention and to help them talk to children about these issues. The programs outlined below can be general or oriented toward adults with children in a specific age group. Programs can be customized and scheduled to meet the individual needs of parents, PTO's, church groups, community organizations, and other groups. Programs are listed below.

### ***General Information on Child Sexual Abuse - 1 Hour Program***

Topics discussed include: what is sexual abuse?; reasons why children tell and don't tell; what all children should know to help keep them safe; how to talk to your children about abuse; what to do if a child discloses abuse; and resources for parents and other caretakers..

### ***Identifying and Responding To Bullying Behavior— 1 Hour Program***

Topics discussed include: different types and forms of bullying; the importance of responding to bullying behavior and how to respond; how to help children with bullying problems; and when your child is the bully.

### ***Let's Talk About Keeping Our Bodies Safe! - 1 Hour Program***

This workshop is available for parents to attend with pre-school aged children. The workshop is designed to help parents talk with their young children about keeping their bodies safe.

Additionally, the SATRC can provide parents and other adults with one or two-hour programs on any topic concerning sexual abuse and violence. Workshops presented in communities include: *Helping Children Deal with Bullying, Sexual Harassment in the Workplace, Sexual Abuse, and Acquaintance Rape.*

All programs can be tailored to meet specific needs, per request.

Cost: Fees for the Sexual Assault & Trauma Resource Center's educational and training programs vary by type of program.
